WHO WE ARE AND WHAT WE DO

SKIF is a Melbourne based Jewish youth movement, catering for 8-18 year-olds. SKIF runs weekly Sunday meetings between 3-5pm at Waks House (281 Hawthorn Rd, Caulfield). With fully trained leaders (helper), SKIFists take part in activities held in a fun and social atmosphere. As well as Sunday meetings, SKIF runs three camps every year and holds many other functions.

SKIF was founded in Eastern Europe as the youth organization of the Jewish Labour Bund and provided Jewish children of the time with hours of enjoyment and with an enriched sense of their place in the world. SKIF established itself in Melbourne in 1950 and has continued this proud tradition for over 50 years.

SKIF has three core ideological principles:

CHIVERSHAFT— חברשאַפֿט

Equality and Empathy (Socialism and Social Awareness)

DOIKAYT— דאָיקייט

That Jews can and should build vibrant communities right here, right now.

YIDDISHKAYT— ייִדישקייט

Fostering Jewish identity through Jewish and Yiddish culture.

All the helper (leaders) are responsible and have undergone a training course, but don't let that make you think that's sucked the fun out of us.
